



Academic Probation Form

Every student must maintain a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 3.0 or higher to be considered in good standing and permitted to graduate.

If a student's CGPA falls below 3.0, he/she will be placed on academic probation. **The probationary period is one semester during which time the student must return to good standing by raising his/her CGPA to a 3.0.** It is recommended that the student develops a plan with his/her academic advisor to raise their CGPA. **If the student does not raise the CGPA, he/she will be subject to dismissal at the discretion of the Program and the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.** The Master of Public Health requires a grade of C or higher in all course work. If the student earns a lower grade, the student must repeat the course and achieve a grade of C or higher. Probationary status is not recorded on a student's transcript or elsewhere in the student's permanent academic record.
