NPCR Social Security Death Index (SSDI)

- -Secure website used to locate deceased individuals and verify follow-up information on patients
- -A new SSA policy regarding the type of information that may be released via the SSDI database has resulted in a large number of deletions within the SSDI file. So while access to the SSDI database may be useful; it may not be as extensive as it once was.
- -User ID and password are required for access
- -To enhance the security of the SSDI Web site, the **general user account has been** deactivated and individual log-in accounts are being established.
 - If you attempt to use the general user account log-in, you will receive notification to contact <u>support@npcrcss.org</u> for new log-in credentials.
