

NPCR Social Security Death Index (SSDI)

- Secure website used to locate deceased individuals and verify follow-up information on patients
- A new SSA policy regarding the type of information that may be released via the SSDI database has resulted in a large number of deletions within the SSDI file. So while access to the SSDI database may be useful; it may not be as extensive as it once was.
- User ID and password are required for access
- To enhance the security of the SSDI Web site, the **general user account has been deactivated and individual log-in accounts are being established.**
 - If you attempt to use the general user account log-in, you will receive notification to contact support@npcrcss.org for new log-in credentials.
 - **If you do not have a username and password, please contact support@npcrcss.org for assistance.** Please provide the following information within your email:
 - Name
 - Organization
 - Title(optional)
 - Office Phone
 - Office email
