All healthcare facilities\* are to submit their cases in accordance with the LTR's Timely Data Reporting Policy. **The submission dates shown above include a one-month grace period. <sup>^</sup>Due to extended 2018 v18 software delays, the LTR has granted all healthcare facilities an additional grace period as indicated above. 2018 case submissions are to commence on June 2019 with catch-up thru August 2019. All facilities need to resume the LTR regular case submission schedule by SEPTEMBER 2019.**

\*Healthcare facilities without a cancer registry whose medical records cannot be remotely accessed by the Louisiana Tumor Registry shall be exempt from this policy due to state travel restrictions and related expenses.

**Please notify your regional director/coordinator immediately should any submission issues arise.** In accordance with the aforementioned policy, failure to meet this submission schedule will be *handled on a case-by-case basis* by your regional director/coordinator and *may result* in a \$45 per case abstraction fee.
