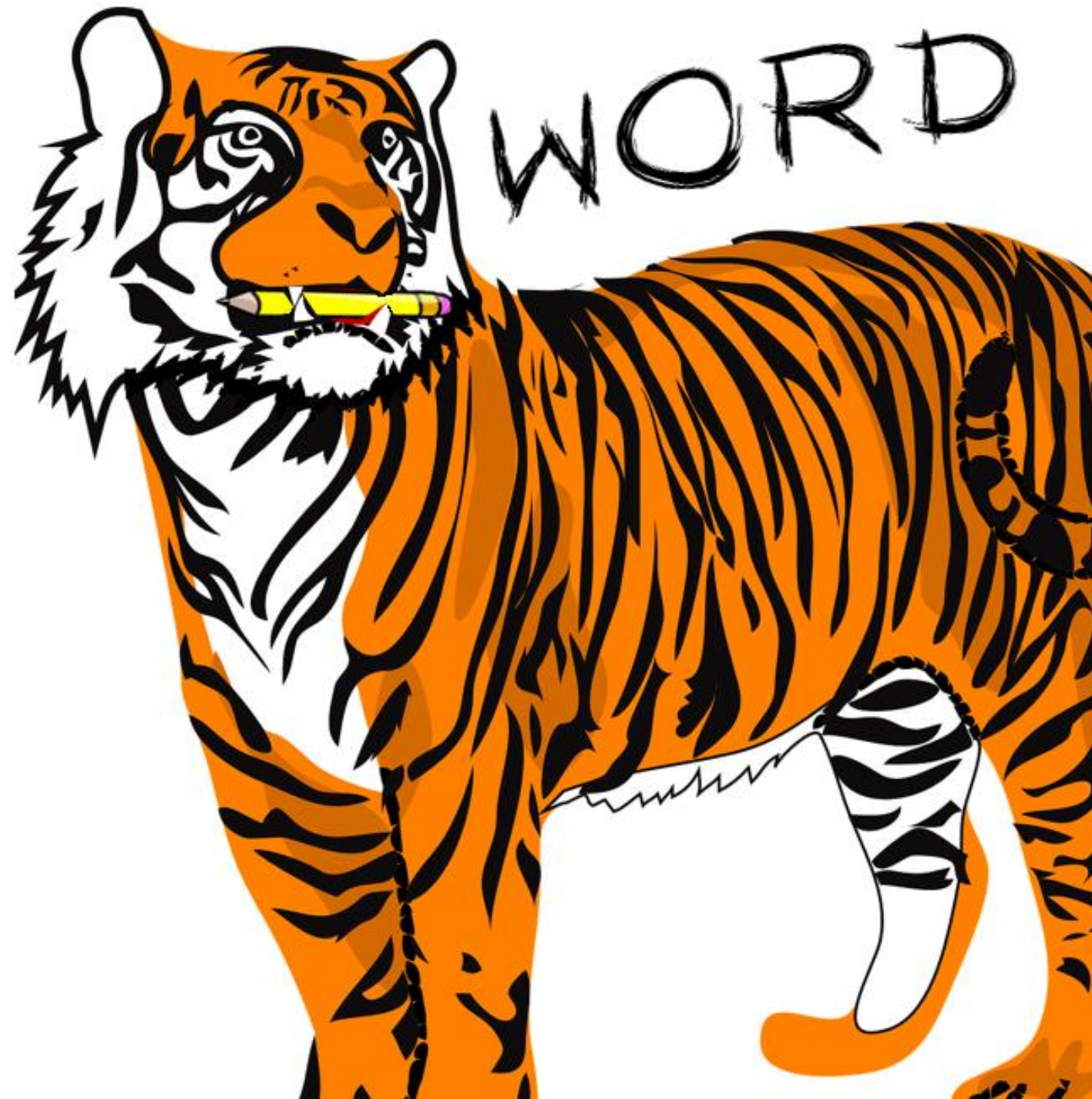

Elizabeth T. H. Fontham Award for Outstanding Community Service

- **Submission Deadline: March 28th**
- The Fontham Award is given once a year in recognition of outstanding achievement in community service outside of the classroom. This \$250 award will be presented to the student who demonstrates the highest level of commitment and success in working with community members and organizations/systems that serve them. The student's service must take place during his/her time enrolled at the School of Public Health (SPH).
- The award is open to all MPH, MS and PhD students. Students can self-nominate, or be nominated by a SPH student, faculty or staff member, an outside organization, or a community member. Students will be judged by level of involvement/commitment, length of service, and outcomes/accomplishments.

- **Submission Deadline: April 25th**
- The Office of Public Health Practice and Community Engagement defines community service hours as hours spent working collaboratively with and through groups of people affiliated with local nonprofit, independent, and community-based organizations focused on improving the quality of life for community residents. Specifically for public health faculty, staff, and students, in line with the School of Public Health's mission, service hours focus on advancing the public's health and addressing issues affecting the well-being of the state of Louisiana. Our combined efforts serve as catalysts for improving the public's health, public health programs, and public health practice.
