

CLINICAL IMAGE Reportability Using Imaging RADS (Reporting and Data Systems)

Since 2018, SEER has designated the following categories of imaging RADS to be clinically REPORTABLE:

LI-RADS (LIVER Cases)

- Category LR-5 OR LR-5V ONLY
- Use the date of the LR-5 or LR-5V scan as the date of diagnosis when it is the earliest confirmation of the malignancy.
- If there is no statement of the LI-RADS score but there is reference that a lesion is in the Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network (OPTN) 5 category, report based on the OPTN class of 5. OPTN class 5 indicates that a nodule meets radiologic criteria for hepatocellular carcinoma

PI-RADS (PROSTATE Cases)

- Category 4 OR 5 only
- Are to be considered as REPORTABLE, unless there is other information to the contrary.
- Per SINQ 20170023, use the date of the PI-RADS 4 or 5 scan as the date of diagnosis when it is the earliest confirmation of the malignancy.
