VIN, VAIN and AIN: A Reportability Issue

VIN III, VAIN III and AIN III of the anus or anal canal (C210-C211) are **reportable** to the Louisiana Tumor Registry (LTR). Starting **January 1, 2023** VIN II, VAIN II and AIN II of the anus or anal canal (C210-C211) **also reportable** to the LTR.

When VIN II-III; VAIN II-III or AIN II-III is stated by a pathologist, it is interpreted to mean the *pathologist is <u>not certain</u> whether it is a VIN/VAIN/AIN II or VIN/VAIN/AIN III*.

As a result, for cases with a pathological description of either VIN II-III OR VIN II/III; VAIN II-III OR VIN II/III; VAIN II-III OR VIN II/III, <u>reportability</u> to the LTR is <u>dependent on diagnosis year</u>:

- Cases **diagnosed prior to 2012** with the above pathological description **ARE REPORTABLE** to the LTR
- However, for cases diagnosed on January 1, 2012 thru December 31, 2022, they are no longer reportable <u>UNTIL/UNLESS VIN III, VAIN III, AIN III OR carcinoma in situ (CIS) is</u> <u>confirmed</u>.
 - VULVA/VAGINA EXCEPTION: For cases dxd January 1, 2018 forward, If final dx is documented as high grade squamous intraepithelial lesion (HGSIL)/ VIN II-III OR high grade squamous intraepithelial lesion (HGSIL)/ VAIN II-III, IT IS REPORTABLE to the LTR as 8077/2
 - Per SEER, HGSIL is a synonym for squamous intraepithelial neoplasia, grade III for vulva and vagina only.
- Cases diagnosed on January 1, 2023 forward with the above pathological description ARE REPORTABLE to the LTR
