

## Academic Probation Form

Students must maintain a cumulative GPA (CGPA) of 3.0 or higher for graduate students or 2.5 CGPA or higher for BSPH students to be considered in good standing and permitted to graduate.

If a student's CGPA falls below the above standard, the student will be placed on academic probation. **The probationary period is one semester during which time the student must return to good standing by raising the CGPA to a 3.0 for graduate students or 2.5 for undergraduate students.** It is recommended that the student develops a plan with their academic advisor to raise their CGPA. **If the student does not raise the CGPA, they will be subject to dismissal at the discretion of the Program and the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.**

Additionally, the School of Public Health requires a grade of C or higher in all coursework. If the student earns a lower grade, the student must repeat the course and achieve a grade of C or higher.
