All healthcare facilities\* are to submit their cases in accordance with the LTR's Timely Data Reporting Policy. <mark>The</mark> submission dates shown above include a *one-month grace period*.

^After the 2023 software update release in mid-September, CNExT registries have been unable to set unknown & lymphoma primaries to complete. A new version 2.23.1.009 is set to be released soon to correct these issues. As a result those state hospital registries unable to transmit **2023 Unknown & Lymphoma primaries will have until NOVEMBER 30<sup>th</sup> 2023 to submit their COMPLETED JANUARY-APRIL 2023 cases.** 

\*Healthcare facilities without a cancer registry whose medical records cannot be remotely accessed by the Louisiana Tumor Registry shall be exempt from this policy due to state travel restrictions and related expenses.

Please notify your regional director/coordinator *immediately* should any submission issues arise. In accordance with the aforementioned policy, failure to meet this submission schedule will be *handled on a case-by-case basis* by your regional director/coordinator and *may result* in a \$45 per case abstraction fee or the actual cost of screening, abstracting, coding, and editing, whichever is greater levied by the LTR in agreement with the LTR's Legislative Rule (LAC 48:V. Chapter 85).
