NIH plans to implement the newquestions for RPPRs submitted on or after October 1, 2024.
- The Simplified Framework for NIH Peer Review Criteria retains the five regulatory criteria (Significance, Investigators, Innovation, Approach, Environment) but reorganizes them into three factors two will receive numerical scores and one will be evaluated for sufficiency.
