Updates include (1) modernizing security standards provided in the "NIH Security Best Practices for Controlled-Access Data Subject to the NIH Genomic Data Sharing (GDS) Policy" and (2) establishing minimum expectations for access to controlled-access data by developers. **Effective January 25, 2025**.
