- Retirement of NIH's Automated Just-in-Time Email Notification: the eRA system-generated email notification announcing the availability to submit Just-in-Time information for an application in eRA Commons will be retired as of October 1, 2024. This change has no impact on an applicant's ability to submit Just-in-Time information upon request from staff at the awarding institute or center. [More](#).
