- **Key Changes proposed to cut the HHS budget:**
 1. Major agency cuts: Funding for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the National Institutes of Health (NIH) would drop by more than 40%, eliminating major initiatives like the Ending the HIV Epidemic Initiative and chronic disease prevention programs.
 2. Agency eliminations: The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), and Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) would be dismantled, and selected activities merged into the new Administration for a Healthy America.

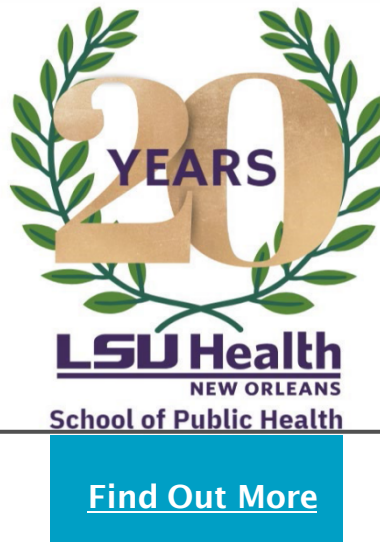
